The components of Epiglass coating formulation have been assessed and it is confirmed that all are on the approved list of substances in American Food and Drug Administration Code of Federal Regulations Title 21 Part 175.300 *Substances for use as components of coatings - Resinous and polymeric coatings*. This part of the regulations covers:

**Coatings applied as a continuous film or enamel over a metal substrate, or coatings intended for repeated food-contact use and applied to any suitable substrate as a continuous film or enamel that serves as a functional barrier between the food and the substrate.**

Samples consisting of Epiglass coated on to sheet metal specimens have been extraction tested with 50% ethanol representing alcoholic beverages with alcohol concentrations up to 50%, with test conditions (E) in Table 2 of Part 175.300, representing conditions of use: *Room temperature filled and stored (no thermal treatment)*. The quantity of extract from the test was below the limits specified for:

- a coating intended for or employed as a component of a container not exceeding 1 gallon and intended for one time use.
- a coating intended for or employed as a component of a container having a capacity in excess of 1 gallon and intended for one time use.
- a coating intended for or employed as a component of a container for repeated use.

Epiglass complies with American Food and Drug Administration Code of Federal Regulations Title 21 Part 175.300 as coatings on containers of all sizes for one time and repeated use, with alcoholic beverages with alcohol concentrations up to 50% by volume and *Room Temperature* conditions of contact.
